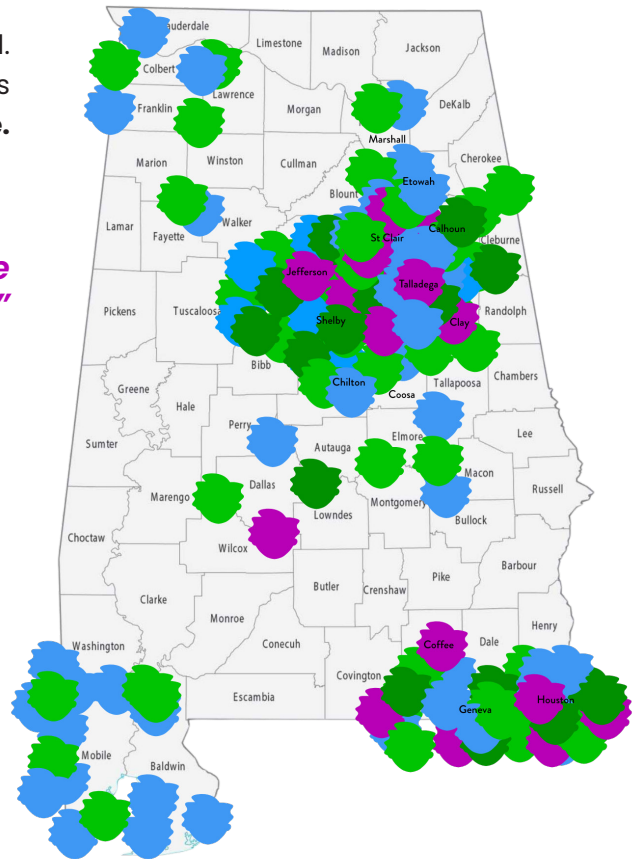


Not just for Pre-K

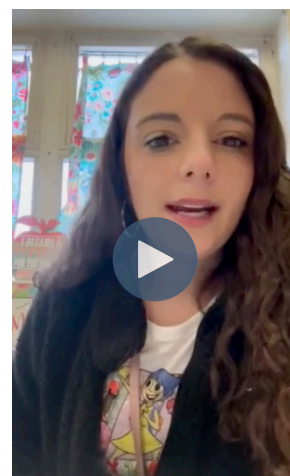
